Homeschool Program Overview

Over the years, West-Mont Christian Academy's tradition of being a parent-run school has helped us to understand the diverse needs of today's family. More than ever, parents are taking seriously their God-given responsibility for the education of their children, as we should be. Many are choosing Home Based Education, or Homeschooling.

Perhaps you are homeschooling your children at this time, know someone who homeschools, or are prayerfully considering this alternate form of education. You may be wondering, "Must homeschooling be a 'solo' venture?" or "What resources are available to help my children (and me) in this educational adventure?" West-Mont Christian Academy (WCA) would like to help you in answering your questions and to help your school experience be a success.



Homeschool program benefits are listed below. Additionally, your child can take Standardized Achievement Testing in the required grades (Grades 3, 5, 8, & 11), attend field trips (MS/HS relating to their WCA course and in Elementary with their related grade), and attend Chapel services. We also offer teacher referrals for portfolio review. There is a separate charge for portfolio reviews and these appointments are set up independently with the teacher.

Homeschool Registration Fee is \$100 for each new student, \$50 for current students.

Homeschool Students Grades 9 to 12

Homeschool students Grades 9 to 12 must take at least one WCA full credit course (for the entire school year) to participate in Extracurricular Activities. Registration begins May 1, 2011 for the 2011-12 school year. Course availability is dependent upon specific class size. The cost breakdown is as follows:

- **One Class: \$ 1,320.00**
- **Two Classes: \$ 2,640.00**
- **Three Classes: \$ 3,960.00**



Upon registering for one full credit course, high school students may participate in the following additional elective classes, sports, and activities at a cost of \$150 for each class/activity chosen:

- **Additional Courses**, which are partial-credit and space permitting, such as Chorus, Art Class, Phys Ed Class, Karate, and Computer Technology Class.
- **Extracurricular Activities:** i.e. Spring Musical.
- **On-line Courses:** Cost varies with courses.
- **H.S. Sports:** Tri-County League & Keystone State Athletic Conference. \$150 per sport played.
Girls: Volleyball, Basketball, Softball, Field Hockey
Boys: Soccer, Basketball, Wrestling, Baseball

Homeschool Students Grades 6 to 8

Homeschool students Grades 6 to 8 may register beginning May 1, 2011 for the 2011-12 school year. Course availability is dependent upon specific class size. Middle school students may participate in the following elective classes, sports, and activities at a cost of \$150 for each class/activity chosen:

- **Elective Classes** such as Chorus, Art Class, Music Theory, Karate, Phys Ed.
- **Middle School Sports:** \$150 per sport played.
Girls: Volleyball, Basketball, Softball, Field Hockey.
Boys: Soccer, Basketball, Wrestling, Baseball.
- **Extracurricular Activities:** Spring Musical.
