

West-Mont Christian Academy Technology User Agreement

We live in a rapidly changing world where the integration of technology is a daily challenge. West-Mont Christian Academy students must be prepared to successfully utilize the benefits of advanced technology, and do so in a God-honoring manner. Please carefully review, sign, and return this user agreement to the school office. If you have any questions about the agreement, please contact the school administrator, Dr. James Smock (James.Smock@West-Mont.org).

Students may not use or access any portion of the school's network or technological services prior to their parents signing this agreement.

The Academy provides state-of-the-art active content filtering within the school's local area network. No filtering system can guarantee that a student will not stumble across objectionable material. The school instructs students on appropriate procedures should such a rare event occur (Immediately power down the monitor and inform the teacher.). West-Mont Christian Academy is committed to providing a safe technological environment for its students. The Academy reserves the right to define what objectionable content is.

All student/parent-owned iPads must have the school's Mobile Device Management software installed to be used on the school campus. The school's network and iPad 1:1 Program exists for the advancement of the educational program only. All non-educational uses may be restricted by the Academy. As with cell phones, student iPads may not use cellular access while on campus. (Within the iPad 1:1 program, parents may choose a Mobile Device Management profile that allows for non-educational use of the iPad off-campus.)

The school works to maintain confidentiality of all student, school, and personal data. However, anyone using school-related technology should have no expectation of privacy. If a need arises, or if required by law enforcement, the Academy has the ability to track all Internet usage and content within its network and on iPad devices that have the Mobile Device Manager installed. WCA does not have the ability to control iPads off campus; only the location of the device is monitored off campus.

Intentional misuse of the school's network, technological services, or iPad Program, by a student or parent may result in disciplinary action by the administration - up to and including expulsion of the student and recovery of real costs associated with those damages. Willful damage to the Academy's technological program may also result in legal action against the offending party. The Academy reserves the right to define what constitutes misuse or willful damage.

All West-Mont Christian Academy students and families agree to cooperate in advancing a safe, secure, and effective technological experience for West-Mont Christian Academy students and families. By signing, parents affirm the provisions and intent of this agreement for as long as their current, and future, students are enrolled in the Academy.
